For trucks with starter key

(1): If possible, turn off the starter switch and remove the key.

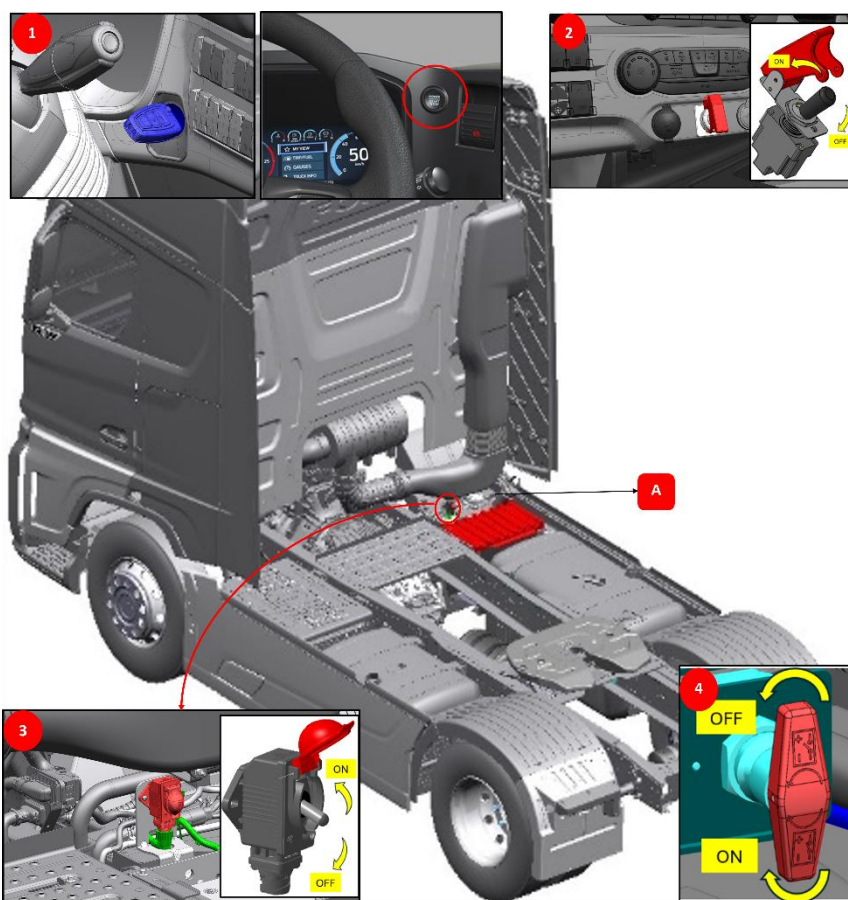
For trucks with start/stop button
Short press the button.

For trucks with ADR: Press the battery main switch (2). Turn the battery main switch (3) or (4) to OFF position.

Note: For trucks with ADR, the main switch is a physical power cut-off. The main switch opens the ADR relays to disconnect the 12 V batteries.



The location of the battery box is the same in F-MAX vehicles. Its location does not change. The pictures show the standard positioning (A). The battery main switch should be used to turn off the voltage in the vehicle.

8. Towing/ transportation/ storage

1. The towing eye fastening point is located under the front bumper



2. Shut down the power of the vehicle (See section 3. Disable direct hazards / safety regulations).

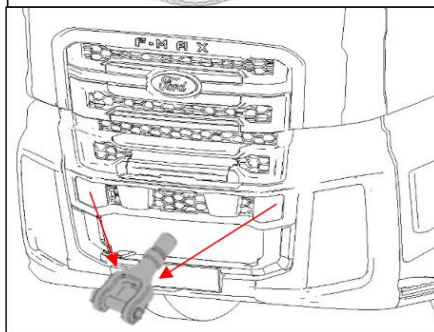
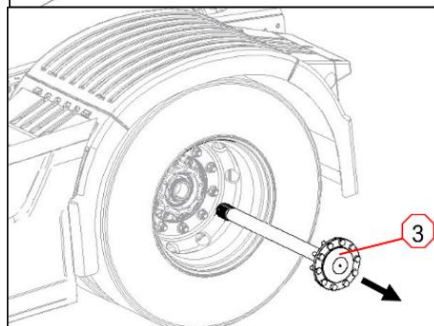
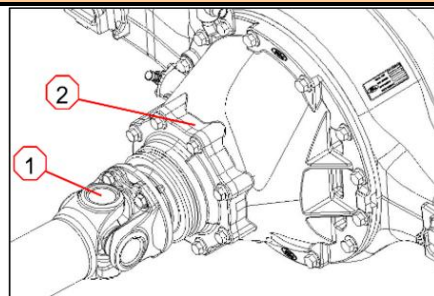
3. Keep away from inflammable and explosive materials.

Allowed Methods:


1. Towing. **(Note: Use only front towing eye for towing the vehicle with all wheels on the ground).**

2. The driver to the wheels is disabled by either uncoupling the propeller shaft (1) from the driven axle (2) or by removing the drive shafts (3).
